

Join the EUPRERA Paper Development Workshop 2024 in Bucharest

An engaged environment to discuss and develop
research papers for competitive journals.

The Paper Development Workshop (PDW) is a structured workshop with a highly interactive format focused on developing papers for publication in top academic journals. Selected papers will be discussed with peers as well as with specially invited senior discussants (advanced scholars with very strong expertise in the focus area of the respective papers) who provide feedback based on their experience and with a particular emphasis on publishing in highly competitive journals.

The PDW is a closed workshop format for authors of accepted papers and the invited senior respondents. It will take place as a pre-conference (mid-day to afternoon) on the opening day of the EUPRERA conference, 11 September 2024.

WHO CAN APPLY?

All scholars are invited to apply. Submitters of both short-length and full-length research papers are eligible for the PDW. Full-length research papers are, however, given higher consideration as the PDW is meant to support the publication of completed works.

HOW TO APPLY?

Submissions for the PDW are made during standard paper submissions for the EUPRERA congress. The deadline for submissions is 15 March 2024.

SELECTION PROCESS

Once papers are accepted for the main congress, they enter the PDW selection process. In addition to the congress reviews, top papers are evaluated by the PDW committee for their quality and publication potential, and the career stage of the applicant(s). In case of high demand, preference is given to rather mature full-paper submissions and to submissions from main authors who are aiming for promotion into tenured faculty positions (esp. mid-career researchers).
